  - a) **Renewal Applications – Board Review**
    - i) **Josie Harding, ATR-001215 – Reinstatement**  
Ms. Harding was not present. The Board determined that Ms. Harding practiced for less than 30 days after her license expired. Ms. Ingram moved the Board approve Ms. Harding’s reinstatement and issue a confidential advisory letter for practicing after her license expired. Mr. Peterson seconded the motion. Following discussion, Ms. Ingram moved the Board reinstate Ms. Mumaw’s license and offer a consent agreement to include two years of probation and a \$1,000 civil penalty. Mr. Peterson seconded the motion. Mr. Freas asked if continuing education should be required as well. Ms. Ingram agreed that continuing education be included and amended her motion to reinstate Ms. Mumaw’s license through a consent agreement to include, two years of probation, a \$1,000 civil penalty, and six hours of continuing education. Mr. Peterson

seconded the amended motion. The motion passed by roll call vote. Mr. Freas – Aye, Mr. Peterson – Aye, Ms. Ingram – Aye
